Notes

The great thing about this song is that it is so adaptable. You can change it around and add and subtract parts to make it fit whatever you want to do. The order of most of it does not matter (in fact I purposefully try to mix around the "Can't go..." parts.

I have heard others sing this as a bear hunt and a lion hunt. When I grew up it was a Cheese Moose. I like that because it is different enough that it involves the imagination that much more, but you could "hunt" anything.

I also love the clapping beat. The kids tend to get understandably wild and excited after each mini adventure. When you clap the beat before each chorus, it lets them focus on the clapping and they always settle down.
